# Indication

Following symptoms in persons with moderate physical strength who have dry skin with unhealthy complexion and get hot flashes:

Menstrual irregularity, dysmenorrhea, chi-no-michi-sho\*, menopausal disorders, neurosis, and eczema/dermatitis.



\*Chi-no-michi-sho is a generic term of neuropsychiatric symptoms such as anxiety and irritation and physical symptoms due to fluctuation of female hormones caused by menstruation, pregnancy, childbirth or menopause.

# ! CAUTION FOR USE

## Consultation

- 1. The following persons should consult a physician, pharmacist or registered distributor before taking this medicine.
  - (1) Persons undergoing medical treatment from a physician.
  - (2) Pregnant women or women suspected of being pregnant.
  - (3) Persons who have a gastrointestinal weakness and tend to diarrhea.
- 2. The following symptoms may be adverse reactions of this medicine. If any of the following symptoms occur, stop taking this medicine immediately and consult a physician, pharmacist or registered distributor with this instruction leaflet.

Gastrointestinal system	Loss of appetite, gastric distress	

In very rare cases the following serious symptoms may occur. In this case, consult a physician immediately.

Symptom's name	Symptoms		
Interstitial pneumonia	Shortness and/or difficulties of breath when go upstairs or overwork, sudden dry cough and/or fever and its continuance.		
Hepatic function failure	Following symptoms appear: Fever, itching, rash, jaundice (yellowing of skin and white of eyes), brown urine, whole-body tiredness, loss of appetite.		
Mesenteric phlebosclerosis	Long-term use of this medicine may cause following symptoms repetitively: Abdominal pain, diarrhea, constipation, abdominal bloating.		

- 3. A following symptom may appear after taking this medicine. If the symptom continues or worsen, consult a physician, pharmacist or registered distributor. Take this leaflet with you: Diarrhea
- 4. If you take this medicine regularly for a long periods, consult a physician, pharmacist, or registered distributor.

#### Dosage and administration

Take the following doses with water or warm water before or between meals. (Between meals means 2-3 hours after meals.)

# Ingredient and amount

3 packets  $(2.5 \text{ g} \times 3 : 7.5 \text{ g})$  of this medicine contains 4.3 g of the dried extract (Unseiin extract) from the following mixed crude drugs.

Japanese Angelica Root	3.0 g	Coptis Rhizome	1.5 g
Rehmannia Root	$3.0~\mathrm{g}$	Scutellaria Root	1.5 g
Peony Root	3.0 g	Gardenia Fruit	1.5 g
Cnidium Rhizome	3.0 g	Phellodendron Bark	1.5 g

The inactive ingredients contained are Lactose Hydrate, Corn Starch and Magnesium Stearate.

### Precautions for storage and handling

- (1) Store in a cool, low humidity place away from direct sunlight.
- (2) Keep out of reach of children.
- (3) Do not transfer the medicine to a different container. (It may lead to misuse or alter the quality of the drug.)
- (4) When you take this medicine in divided dose, fold over the opened edge of the packet and store it. The remaining medicine should be taken within 2 days.
- This product is manufactured from natural crude drugs. There may be slight differences in the color and taste of the product. There is no change in the effect.
